

## Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

**Subject:** Dodd-Frank Act (Section 1502) “Conflict Minerals in the Democratic Republic of Congo”

c3controls supports the end of violence and human rights violations surrounding the mining of certain minerals from the conflict region of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries. As such we support the objectives of the Dodd-Frank Act (Section 1502) and we’re committed to procuring only conflict free minerals. “Conflict Minerals” refer to gold, tin, tantalum, and tungsten—but also refer to derivatives of cassiterite, columbite-tantalite, and wolframite.

To the very best of our knowledge, c3controls products are assembled and processed without using any Conflict Minerals originating, sourced and/or smelted from the Democratic Republic of Congo.

The information provided in this document is based upon technical data believed to be reliable and is accurate to the best of our knowledge. On an ongoing basis, we conduct investigations in our supply chain to ensure that all metals used in our products comply with the relevant requirements. The information provided is subject to change as additional experience and knowledge is gained.

Because we appreciate the gravity of this issue and the suffering of the people in the DRC, c3controls is committed to responsible procurement practices. We refuse to abet the violence connected with mining in the DRC.
